IMPORTANT

It is important that you sign and date your Will correctly, and that your signature has been witnessed in accordance with the law, otherwise a beneficiary may forfeit their right to part of your estate.

Witnesses must not be beneficiaries or the spouse or civil partner of a beneficiary

At the same time as you sign your Will, you must either send a clear scan or photograph of the attestation page of the will to info@willpack.co.uk or send the *original* of this form which should be signed at the same time as the will with the same witnesses. If you are returning the *original* of this form, please send it to the address below.

Do not return your signed Will to this address. Please also note that we cannot accept copies of this form.

Completing either of the above will allow us to ensure that the Will has been signed correctly and also may be used as evidence of correct attestation should the will be lost.
